

# 2015 Howell Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon

### 2015 Vintage

The 2015 growing season began with record setting rains in December, followed by the driest January on record. There were no hard freezes during the winter, which contributed to a very early budbreak (late February in some spots). Rain in April shattered the flowers which caused a reduction in crop size, but that's just Mother Nature's way of thinning the crop. With a lighter crop the grapes ripened quickly and evenly, then viola, an ear harvest!

### **The Appellation**

From an appellation defined primarily by elevation, the Howell Mountain AVA lies between 1,800 and 2,400 feet. The terraced vineyards can face to the east, south or west.

## 2015 Tasting Notes

2015 was an extraordinary vintage that fully expresses classic Cabernet style from this famed, high elevation site. Packed with complex aromas of ripe blackberries, cocoa and some delicate minerality, it just begs for another swirl. As this wine opens up, aromas of plum, ripe black berry, cassis and crushed rock can be found. Complex on the palate, ripe concentrated fruit leads the way, evolving into mocha, cedar, leather and spice, all wrapped in a subtle layer of sweet toasty oak. Bold and extracted, elegant and refined, this seductive wine delivers everything we love about Howell Mountain Cabernet. Enjoy now or lay a few bottles down for a few more years.
